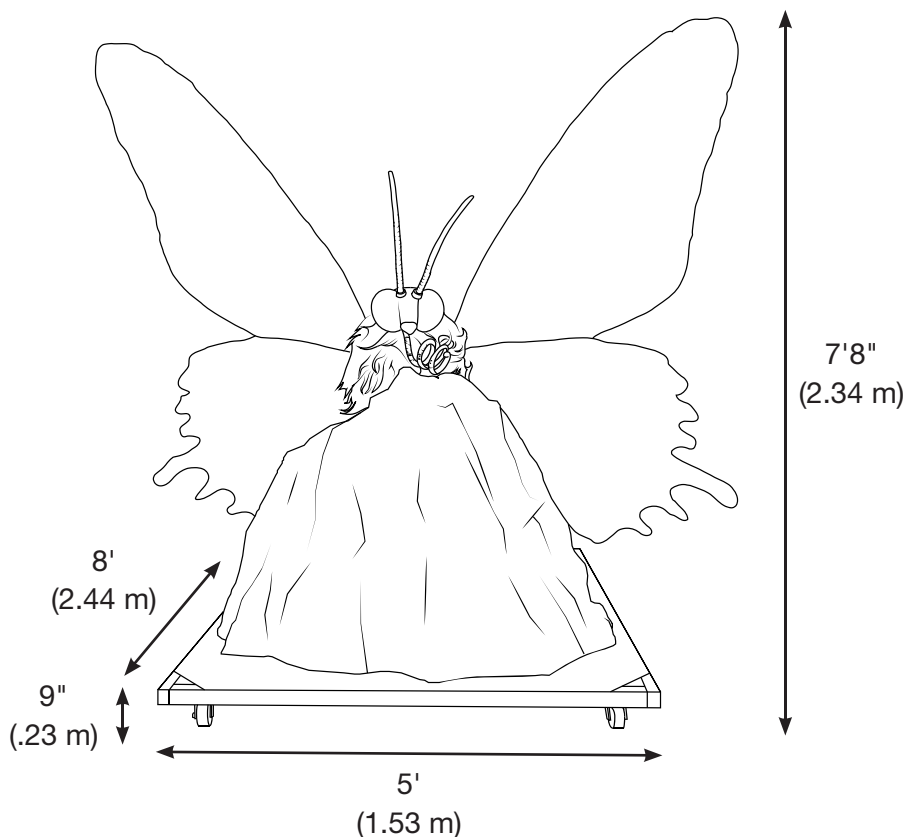


MADAGASCAN SUNSET MOTH



- The Madagascar sunset moth is considered one of the most impressive and appealing looking day-flying moths.
- At first the Madagascar sunset moth was thought to be from China or Bengal, but was later found to be native to Madagascar.
- The colors on the wings originate from the scattering and interference of light by the microstructure of the ribbon-like scales covering the moth's wings. The scales are curved, which creates inter-scale reflection.
