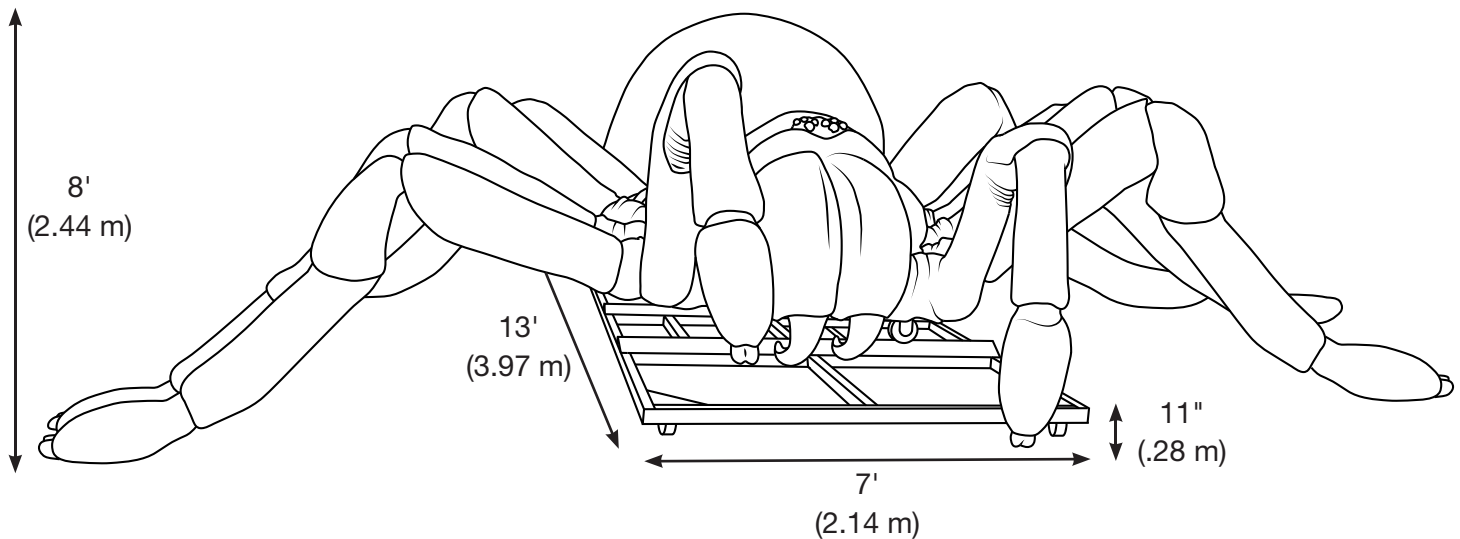


MEXICAN REDKNEE TARANTULA



- To save themselves from a potentially fatal fall, tarantulas have the ability to spin silk from the ends of their feet.
- The Mexican redknee grows slowly and matures relatively late. The females can live up to 30 years, but the males tend to only live for about 5 years.
- Although the male is comparable in size to the female, the male has a much smaller mass.
- As tarantulas grow they molt, on multiple occasions during the year, depending on the tarantula's age. Since the exoskeleton cannot stretch, it has to be replaced by a new one from beneath.
