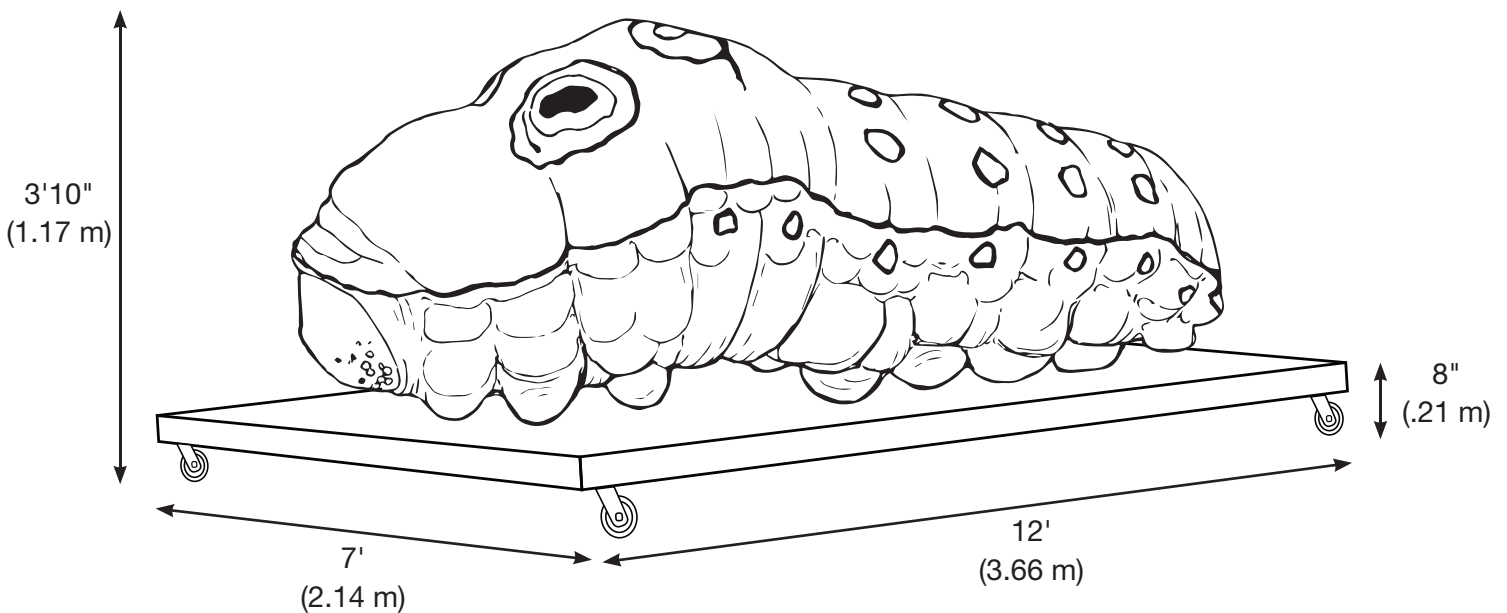




# PHOTO OP CATERPILLAR A



- The spicebush swallowtail is found in the eastern US and southern Ontario, but can also be seen in the American Midwest, Cuba, Manitoba and Colorado.
- The larvae are brightly colored with two large black dots on the thorax that look like eyes with a white highlight.
- The placement of these dots on the swollen thorax creates the illusion that the caterpillars are common garden snakes. Mimicking snakes is a defense mechanism against predators, specifically birds.
