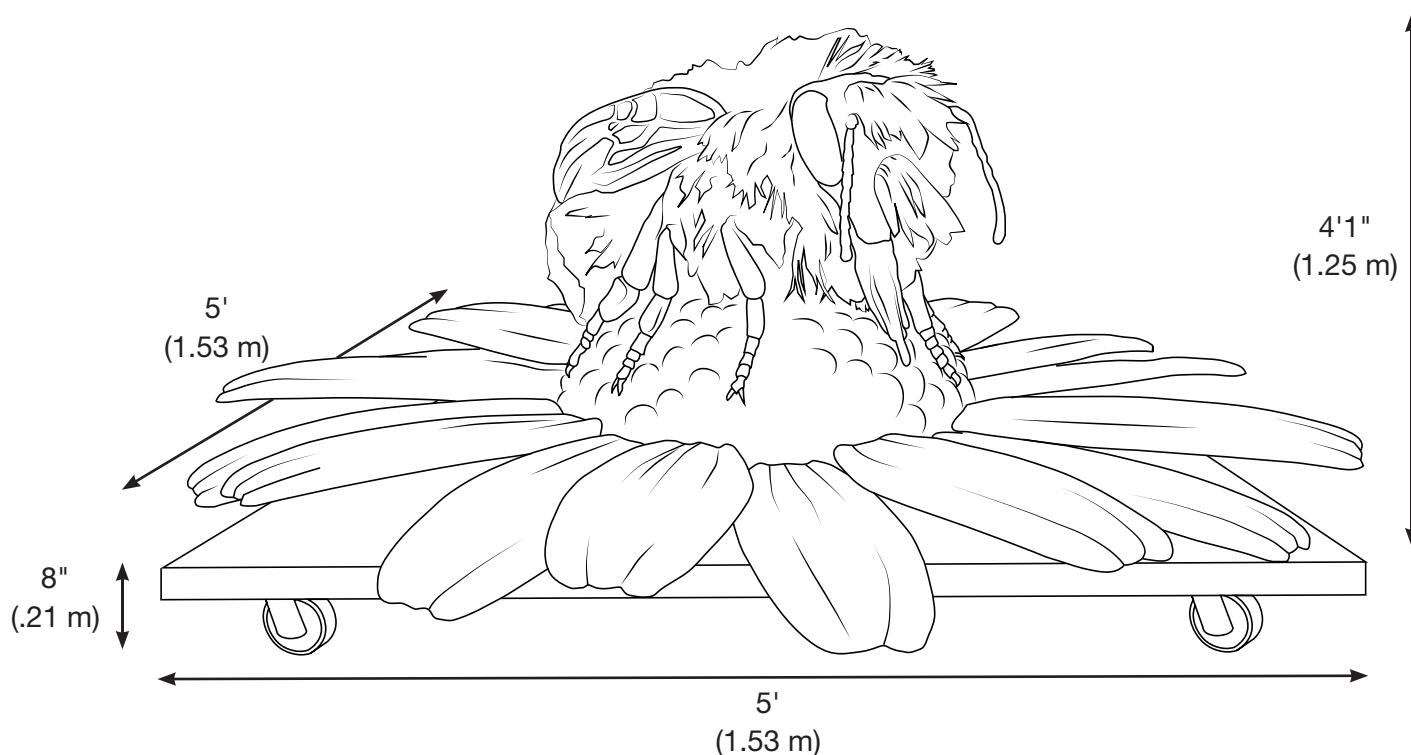


RED-TAILED BUMBLEBEE



- Bumblebees create a loud buzzing sound to vibrate and shake pollen from flowers.
- Red-tailed bumblebees typically appear in June, July, and August. Colonies begin with the queen, in addition to workers and males who keep the colony thriving.
- Bumblebees are a very important part of pollination. For many species of plant, only bees and butterflies have proboscides long enough to pollinate effectively.
