



We thank you for choosing the Phoenix Zoo as a destination for your field trip. For the safety and security of our school visitors, we ask that you inform each of your bus drivers of the procedures to follow when bringing children to the Zoo.

During the summer and in September, we have school/youth groups enter through the Main Entrance. From June 1st through August 31<sup>st</sup>, the Zoo's summer hours are 7 a.m. to 2 p.m.

The entrance procedures are as follows:

1. Enter the Zoo from Galvin Parkway.
2. School buses are welcome to park in our main parking lot from June through August. (For the rest of the year, September through May, school buses should park in the Zoo's overflow parking lot, which is before the main parking lot. This will be the first right hand turn after entering Papago Park. Watch for the School Bus Parking signs.)
3. For ease of loading and unloading, the bus driver can pull up to the curb near the entrance of the Zoo.
4. The representative from your group that is paying should proceed to the TICKET BOOTH, once paid your entire group can cross the bridge and enter through the turnstiles on the left.

With your assistance, we can ensure the safety of each of our school visitors. We thank you for your help in this matter.
