

CZ2U MATERIALS LIST BIRDS

General Supplies

- Electronic Device with access to the internet
 - charging cable/wall plug (if needed)
 - Optional: headphones
- Link/password (found in email titled “Your Camp Week Is Here!”)
- Printer + Paper (to print provided activity sheets)
- Paper or notebook (for making notes, writing down questions, etc.)
- Writing utensil (Pen/pencil)
- Snack/drink

Craft: Build a Bird Feeder

- Cardboard tube
 - Substitutions: pinecone, flat piece of cardboard
- Peanut Butter
 - Substitutions: Non-toxic substance that can be used as adhesive; honey, sun butter or other nut butter, flour/water paste
- Wild Bird Seed
 - Substitutions: crumbled unsweetened cereal, finely chopped plain nuts
- String/twine
 - Substitutions: yarn, ribbon, fabric strips, pipe cleaners
- Scissors (to cut a length of string)
- Pencil [to poke holes]
 - Substitutions: hole punch
- Butter Knife
 - Substitutions: popsicle stick, spoon
- Plate
 - Substitutions: newspaper square, baking sheet, plastic tray

Vulture Yoga

- Yoga mat or towel
 - Substitutions: foam floor tiles, blanket, carpet square

Learning Activity: Wingspans, Feathers and Flight

- Feather Activity Sheet* (See resources section on camp page)
- Airplane template printable* (See resources section on camp page)
- String/twine, cut to differing lengths
- Scissors
- Ruler/measuring tools
 - Substitutions: anything! You could measure in water bottle length, shoe lengths, whatever item is available)
- Straw (optional)
- Tape
- Paper
- Decorative craft items (discretionary – markers, crayons, colored pencils, sequins, poms, stickers, etc.)

- If your favorite animal isn't included, we encourage campers to do some research with the help/permission of an adult.

Items for this activity are at the discretion of camper creativity and available resources. This is a great opportunity to reuse items around the house to give them a second life!

Suggestions:

- Cardboard (toilet paper or paper towel tubes, empty tissue boxes, cereal boxes/other food packaging, corrugated shipping boxes, shoe boxes etc.)
- Scissors
- Paper (white or colored office paper, construction paper, cardstock, etc.)
- Adhesives (craft glue, tacky glue, tape, etc.)
- Wooden craft sticks (popsicle sticks, wooden dowels, toothpicks, etc.)
- Packing materials (Styrofoam, Packing Peanuts, Plastic Air Pillows, etc.)
- Kitchen supplies (aluminum foil, plastic wrap, paper bags, toothpicks, food packaging [ex: plastic produce clamshells, bottlecaps etc.]
- Molding medium (playdoh, air-dry clay, modeling clay, salt dough, etc.)
- Fabric (felt, old clothing items that no longer fit/have holes, fabric scraps)
- String (yarn, twine, ribbon, embroidery floss, old shoelaces, etc.)
- Coloring Utensils (Markers, Crayons, Colored Pencils, chalk, Paint/paintbrush)
- Animal figures/stuffed animals/other small toys
- Decorative craft items (pipe cleaners, pom-poms, sequins, stickers, glitter, rhinestones)
